

Anchorage Convention Centers COVID-19 Statement

Following Friday, March 13, 2020's announcement of the emergency declaration in response to COVID-19, Mayor Ethan Berkowitz directed that all civic, cultural, and recreational facilities where large crowds can gather be closed until March 31 in order to protect and preserve public health and safety.

From Mayor Berkowitz: ***“Anchorage prides itself on being welcoming through the many ways in which we gather with neighbors, friends, and others to enjoy culture, entertainment, and recreation. But right now, our top priority is to flatten the curve – to slow the spread of COVID-19 – so that our healthcare facilities can continue to treat every patient. If we all act together, each one of us can make Anchorage as safe as possible.”***

While we have one confirmed case in Anchorage and no cases connected to the Anchorage Convention Centers (Dena'ina and Egan Center) we believe that we must do all that we can to ensure a safe and healthy environment for our community, which at this time calls for us to minimize gatherings while maintaining the cleanest environment possible pursuant to the recommendations of local, state and federal authorities.
